# Rules & Regulations

November 2010

### 1. Fees

<b>1.1</b>	<b>Requests for a reduction in fees due to child missing games and training through injury.</b>	The committee discussed this and decided against the proposal.
<b>1.2</b>	<b>Training Fees When Not Playing</b>	“Training only’ box on Registration form to cover insurance. Training levy \$5 per session up to a maximum of \$50 and must be paid up front.
<b>1.3</b>	<b>Fee Refunds and Team Sizes</b>	Teams need at least 6 player fees to pay for a season to play. If wanting a refund it must be put in writing to the committee and will be considered case by case.
<b>1.4</b>	<b>Fees and U19/20 Teams</b>	All U20 Boys or U19 Girls team must pay up front and if a registration form has not been signed by the parent/guardian they must pay up front.
<b>1.5</b>	<b>Refunding Fees</b>	To be addressed case by case –All players pay a non-refundable \$30.00 deposit when registering a player and then look at all cases individually.
<b>1.6</b>	<b>Multiple Player Fee Discounts</b>	Fee discounts, to the value as determined by the committee each season, may apply when multiple siblings are registered where the fee is payable by the same parent/guardian who is financially responsible for all the siblings
<b>1.7</b>	<b>Fee’s when playing in two teams other than filling in.</b>	As fees are determined by the cost of fielding teams for the season, players who play in more than one team (other than filling in up to the maximum of 3 games in the season) are required to register and pay for both teams.  The cost of playing in the second team will be determined by the committee each season.

## 2. Teams

2.1	Team Selection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Players will be placed in sides based upon age and will only be considered for older age groups where places are available.</li> <li>• Players will be selected in teams based upon similar ability and with a focus on team balance.</li> <li>• Subject to points 1&amp;2, continuity of teams will be considered as part of the selection process.</li> <li>• Priority for selection of players in teams will be given to existing players.</li> <li>• Teams will be a maximum of 8 players, with the discretion of the coach to have an additional player.</li> </ul>
2.2	Fielding “Non-Registered” Players	Coaches are not allowed to have fill-ins who are not covered by our insurance. They must pull players from another grade or make do.
2.3	Team Administrators	We need to push for a TEAM Administrator for each team and encourage everyone to SCORE.
2.4	Changing from Dribblers to a team during a season	Cost per player needs to be \$30 admin fee and then at the clubs discretion an amount per game.

## 3. General Club

3.1	Sub Committees	Sub-committee required for Complaints, Member Protection And Policies.
3.2	Membership Forms By Committee Members	Committee members to fill out a membership form every season.
3.3	Constitution	We cannot have our own constitution as we do not have anything that states what a member is.
3.4	Police Check / Working With Children	Coaches over 18 will need to complete a Working With Children Application instead of a Police Check.
3.5	Coach/Team Manager Listings	We need a full list of all coaches, team managers and Police/ WWC checks to be gathered together and collated as one.

## 4. Uniforms

4.1	Cost	New uniforms will now cost \$85.00.
4.2	Second-hand Uniforms	Uniform will be \$40 second-hand.

## 5. Disciplinary Action

<b>5.1</b>	<b>Any disciplinary issues</b>	The disciplinary committee shall consist of at least 3 of the 4 Executive team (President, Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary) and should address the member/s involved. The details of the meeting should be documented and the resolution be noted .
